Ephrata Recreation Center 3 on 3 Basketball Rules

1. Games are 21 points (win by two) or 30 minutes. If a game goes 30 minutes, the score at the whistle will be the final (no win by 2).
2. If a game is tied at the end of 30 minutes, teams will play a 2 minute overtime period. The team with possession at the end of regulation retains possession for the start of OT.
3. Field goals **inside** the arc are 1 point, **behind** the arc 2 points.
4. A coin flip will determine first possession.
5. The ball changes possession after all made baskets.
6. The ball must be taken back on every possession change. Both feet must be behind the arc.
7. The ball must be put in play at the top of the arc. The ball must be checked by the defense before being put in play.
8. The ball must be passed to begin play.
9. Fouls are call your own. Player fouled makes the call.
10. If a player is fouled in the act of shooting and the basket is made, the ball changes possession. If basket is not made the fouled player's team retains possession.
11. All fouls result in the fouled team retaining possession with the following exceptions:
 - When either team gets to 10 points and/or the game is in the last 2 minutes, all fouls will be 1 shot. The ball will change possession after all foul shots regardless of whether the shot is made.
12. **NEW!!** With less than 30 seconds left in a game the defense can intentionally foul by touching the offensive player who has the ball and calling foul. This will stop the clock. Note: This is the only time the defense can call a foul.
13. A 30 second clock will be in effect. If the court monitor thinks a team is stalling, he will issue a warning to the offending team. Any other stalling warnings will result in a change of possession.
- 14 Alternating possession will be in effect on held balls.
- 15 Teams are allowed two - 45 second timeouts/game. Only timeouts under 2 minutes will stop the clock.
16. The court monitor will have the final decision on all disputes.
17. No dunking or hanging on rims. Violation will result in the offending player being disqualified from the tournament.
17. Unsportsmanlike behavior will not be tolerated: Any confrontations, verbal or physical, flagrant fouls, or verbal abuse of court monitors will result in offending players being disqualified from the tournament.
18. **Once a game has begun, no coaching is allowed by anyone other than team members. This includes calling timeouts and making substitutions. Violators will not be allowed in the gym.**
