- 1. Entry forms must be returned to the Ephrata Recreation Center by Wednesday, March 3.**
 - 2. All entries need to be brought to the Rec in a working croc pot by 3:30 p.m. the day of the event.**
 - 3. Contestants should have approximately 3.5 quarts of chili.**
 - 4. All entries must be made from scratch. No special toppings allowed.**
 - 5. A recipe or list of ingredients must accompany each entry.**
 - 6. Judging will begin at 4 p.m. A team of judges will score entries on:**
 - A. appearance (is it appealing, swimming in grease, color contrasts, etc.)**
 - B. spice (too hot, too mild, too bland, it curled my eyebrows)**
 - C. originality (distinguishing features i.e. type of meat, peppers, color, unusual ingredients)**
 - D. overall taste (do the ingredients blend into a delightful mouthful)**
- Note: The organizing committee does not have the wisdom to define chili, therefore, whatever you call chili, we call chili.**
- 7. Judges will determine one overall champion. In addition, the general public will be allowed to taste and vote for the "Peoples Choice" Champion.**
 - 8. The Rec will provide soufflé cups for tasting, contestants need to provide serving spoons.**
